Press Invitation

HKPOP Press Conference: Surveys on “We Hongkongers”, “Civil Society Sponsorship Scheme” and Popularity of CE

Hong Kong Public Opinion Program (HKPOP) under the Hong Kong Public Opinion Research Institute (HKPORI) will hold a press conference **tomorrow**, where HKPOP will announce the following three survey results:

- 1) Latest rolling survey of “We Hongkongers 我們香港人” Initiative covering October 22 to 28, with questions including:
 - o Q1: There are views in the society saying the 7.21 incident involved collusion of the Police Force and triads. How much do you agree or disagree with this view?
 - o Q2: There are views in the society saying there are Chinese People’s Police or People’s Armed Police Force in the Police Force. How much do you believe in this view?
 - o Q3: Some people initiated changes in consumption patterns, such as boycotting or supporting selected brands or shops to express their views toward the anti-extradition law protests. How much do you support or oppose such behavior?
 - o Q4: There are views in the society saying Hong Kong people should seek help from the international community if the SAR government could not safeguard human rights in Hong Kong. How much do you agree or disagree with this view?
 - o Q5: Some people initiated a non-cooperation movement, which involved actions such as blocking traffic and going on strike, to push the government to respond to their demands. How much do you support or oppose the non-cooperation movement?
 - o Q6: There are views in the society saying some people were beaten to death by the police in Prince Edward station on 31 August. How much do you agree or disagree with this view?
 - o Q7: A police truck armed with water cannons shot blue-dyed liquid at South Asians and journalists outside the mosque in Tsim Sha Tsui on Sunday (October 20). The Chief Executive and the Commissioner of Police apologized to the mosque afterward. Do you think the cause of the incident needs to be looked into or people be held accountable?
- 2) A citizen-sponsored question via the Civic Society Sponsorship Scheme: “Do you agree to Hong Kong becoming independent?”
- 3) HKPOP’s tracking surveys on the popularity of Chief Executive and SAR Government

Media are invited to send representatives to attend the press conference and to sponsor any of the above-mentioned surveys, at \$8,000 per question. All sponsors will receive the results in advance. At the press conference, honorary commentators will interpret the results. Details are as follows:
