- Date of survey: 30/3-2/4/2020
- Survey method: Random telephone survey conducted by real interviewers
- Target population: Cantonese-speaking Hong Kong residents aged 18+
- Sample size: 1,005 (including 496 landline and 509 mobile samples)
- Effective response rate: 66.7%
- Sampling error: Sampling error of percentages not more than +/-4%, that of net values not more than +/-6% and that of ratings not more than +/-2.4 at 95% conf. level
- Weighting method: Rim-weighted according to figures provided by the Census and Statistics Department. The gender-age distribution of the Hong Kong population came from "Mid-year population for 2018", while the educational attainment (highest level attended) distribution and economic activity status distribution came from "Women and Men in Hong Kong Key Statistics (2018 Edition)".



• The latest survey shows that the popularity rating of CE Carrie Lam has significantly increased by 3.2 marks since two weeks ago to 25.5. 48% participants give her 0 rating. Her approval rate is 16%, disapproval rate 75%, giving a net popularity of negative 60 percentage points.




