香港民研公布「我們香港人」、特首民望、「區選覓途」 最新數字及啟動「民主社區互助共融」計劃

香港民意研究所之香港民意研究計劃 (香港民研) 將於今天下午 (11 月 29 日) 舉行發布會,發放「我們香港人 We Hongkongers」、其「特殊項目」、香港民研定期發放之特首民望以及「區選覓途 DE Way Out」的最新調查結果。

另外,隨著 2019 年區議會選舉塵埃落定,香港民研決定開展「民主社區互助共融 CICD」計劃,為香港的文明和民主發展揭開新一頁。計劃的宗旨在於為香港人提供平台,透過互相尊重、理性商討、文明討論、同理思維、社交凝聚和在必要時以民主方法排解糾紛等方法去重新融合。和而不同,多元團結,是我們的理想。計劃會透過各個區議員的領導,連結社區成員進行新時代新概念的社區建設。宏觀發展方面,則交由各區議會主席負責帶領。

發布會第一部分會先發放最新調查結果,並由「我們香港人」計劃名譽總監評論。然後,「區選覓途」計劃督導委員會成員會公布有關計劃的最新調查結果。於第三部分,香港民意研究所主席及行政總裁鍾庭耀將會講解「民主社區互助共融」計劃的內容,詳情如下:

HKPOP releases latest results of "We Hongkongers", CE Popularity, "DE Way Out" and launches the "Community Integration through Civility and Democracy" Project

Hong Kong Public Opinion Program (HKPOP) under the Hong Kong Public Opinion Research Institute (HKPORI) will hold a press conference **this afternoon (November 29)**, where HKPOP will announce the latest results of "We Hongkongers 我們香港人" rolling survey, its "Special Module" survey, HKPOP's tracking survey on the popularity of the Chief Executive and "DE Way Out 區選覓途".

Meanwhile, upon completion of the 2019 District Council Election, HKPOP decided to launch the "Community Integration through Civility and Democracy (CICD) 民主社區互助共融" Project in order to bring Hong Kong to new heights in terms of civility and democracy. The purpose of the CICD Project is to provide a means for Hongkongers to re-integrate ourselves through mutual respect, rational deliberations, civilized discussions, personal empathy, social integration, and when needed, resolution of conflicts through democratic means. Unity in diversity is our ideal. CICD would engage Hongkongers across all communities in a modern and brand-new way via the leadership of individual District Councillors within their own service districts and the Chairmen of District Councils where overall macroscopic development is concerned.

In the first part of press conference, survey results will be released and the honorary directors of "We Hongkongers" will interpret the results. Then, members of "DE Way Out" steering group will release latest results of the project. In the third part, Robert Chung, President and CEO of HKPORI will explain the "CICD" project, details as follows:
