香港民研發布會：「我們香港人」及施政報告跟進調查

香港民意研究所之香港民意研究計劃（香港民研）將於明天舉行發布會，屆時將會公布有關「我們香港人 We Hongkongers」倡導計劃的詳情，包括眾籌安排及首輪滾動民調結果。參考自美國白宮聯署網站「We the People」，「我們香港人」倡導計劃旨在讓香港市民就任何議題透過科學化研究了解民情，只要任何人士收集到一萬名聯署，其建議之題目通過核實程序後將會納入調查。詳情參閱：https://www.pori.hk/wehongkongers_factsheet_20191017_chi。

倡導計劃之先導滾動調查由上星期四（10 月 17 日）正式展開，目標是每個工作天收集最少 334 個樣本，以下為先導研究的 5 條問題：

- Q1：社會上有意見認為警方喺 7.21 事件同黑社會合作。你有幾贊成或者反對呢種講法？
- Q2：社會上有意見認為警察之中混入咗中國公安或者武警。你有幾相信呢種講法？
- Q3：社會上有意見認為而家社會狀況不適宜照原定日程舉行區議會選舉。你有幾支持或者反對將區議會選舉押後舉行？
- Q4：有區議會參選人因為同「光復香港 時代革命」口號嘅相關言論被選舉主任查詢政治立場。你認為選舉主任喺考慮候選人資格嘅時候應唔應該考慮呢句口號？
- Q5：美國國會現正審議《香港人權與民主法案》，內容包括制裁美國認為有侵犯香港人權嘅人。你有幾支持或者反對呢個法案？

上述先導研究之首輪結果將於明天的發布會上公布，歡迎派員採訪或贊助上述滾動調查，每題港幣八千元，可以優先獲得結果。此外，香港民研將會同時發放施政報告跟進調查數字，並由客席評論員演繹結果，亦歡迎贊助。發布會詳情如下：

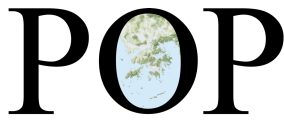

Press Invitation

HKPOP Press Conference: “We Hongkongers” and Policy Address Follow-up Survey

Hong Kong Public Opinion Program (HKPOP) under the Hong Kong Public Opinion Research Institute (HKPORI) will hold a press conference **tomorrow**, where HKPOP will announce the details of “We Hongkongers 我們香港人” Initiative, including the crowdfunding arrangement and the results of first round of rolling survey. With reference to the petition website “We the People” by the White House of the United States, “We Hongkongers” Initiative aims to reflect public sentiment by conducting scientific research on any issues raised by Hong Kong citizens. If any person can mobilize more than 10,000 “petitions”, his or her suggested questions will be included in the survey after passing a verification process. The pilot rolling survey of “We Hongkongers” started officially last Thursday (October 17), with a target sample size of at least 334 per rolling day. The following 5 questions were selected for pilot study:

- Q1: There are views in the society saying the 7.21 incident involved collusion of the Police Force and triads. How much do you agree or disagree with this view?
- Q2: There are views in the society saying there are Chinese People’s Police or People’s Armed Police Force in the Police Force. How much do you believe in this view?
- Q3: There are views in the society saying the District Council Election should not be held as scheduled. How much do you support or oppose postponing the District Council Election?
- Q4: Some candidates of the District Council Election are being questioned on their political stance because of speeches related to the slogan “Liberate Hong Kong, revolution of our times”. Do you think returning officers should take this into consideration when ruling on candidacy?
- Q5: The U.S. Congress is reviewing the Hong Kong Human Rights and Democracy Act, which would sanction people thought to have infringed human rights in Hong Kong. How much do you support or oppose this Act?

First round results of above-mentioned pilot study will be announced at the press conference tomorrow. Media are invited to send representatives to attend the press conference and to sponsor the above-mentioned rolling survey, at \$8,000 per question. All sponsors will receive the results in advance. At the same time, HKPOP will release the findings on the Policy Address first follow-up survey, and honorary commentators will interpret the results. Sponsorship is also welcome. 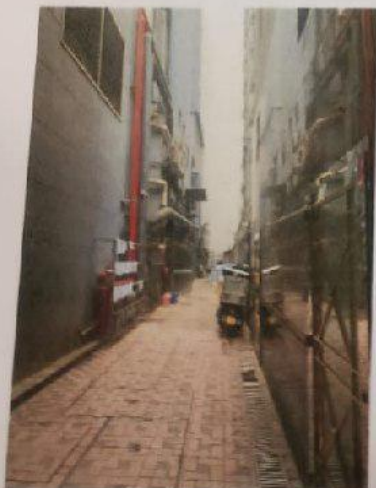
