香港民研下星期一發放「疫後復工指數」最新結果、 「社區健康計劃」第十一號報告及「社區健康資訊系統」第五號報告; 下星期二發放十大政治團體評分

## **Press Invitation**

HKPOP will release next Monday latest results of "Post-Epidemic Work Resumption Index", "Community Health Survey" Report No. 11, and "Community Health Information System" Report No. 5; Next Tuesday it will release the ratings of top ten political groups

As the coronavirus epidemic in Hong Kong subsides, people begin to discuss under what conditions should everyday life resume normal. The Hong Kong Public Opinion Program (HKPOP) under the Hong Kong Public Opinion Research Institute (HKPORI) has promptly constructed a "Post-Epidemic Work Resumption Index" (PEWRI) based on opinion data gathered from scientific surveys for public and policy reference. The latest results will be released at the press conference <a href="mailto:next-Monday">next-Monday</a> (April 27) afternoon. Moreover, the "Community Health Project" of HKPOP continues to collect people's views on the pandemic, latest questions include when to lift the regulation prohibiting gatherings, their standards for work and school resumption, appraisals on the performances of Hong Kong government and the World Health Organization in handling the pandemic, and so on. Its Report No. 11 will be released at the press conference. Besides, the "Community Health Information System (CHIS)" continues to track people's possession of protective masks across different districts, its Report No. 5 will also be released at the same occasion.
