香港民研明日發放核心社會指標、香港市民最熟悉政治人物及解釋評分量尺實驗之安排

香港民意研究所之香港民意研究計劃 (香港民研) 將於明日 (8月18日) 下午舉行發布會，發放核心社會指標及香港市民最熟悉政治人物最新調查結果。根據我們早前進行的公眾諮詢結果，五項核心社會指標的調查頻率會由下半年開始增加至每個月一次，而其他近二十項的非核心社會指標、自由次指標及法治指標則暫定維持半年一次。香港民研會同時解釋有關特首評分量尺實驗的籌款結果及細節安排。

香港民研於五月底宣佈重整「我們香港人」計劃，每星期透過研究所的 Facebook 專頁邀請市民就社會時事議題提供意見題目，然後進行網上投票，並把票數最高的一至多條題目納入「香港民研意見群組」調查，然後公佈結果。本星期進行的是第十三輪調查，題目因應需要增加至兩條，分別為：「人大常委決定現屆立法會繼續履行職責不少於一年，你有幾支持或者反對全體立法會議員繼續出任議員？」和「最近有人建議推行『港版健康碼』，只准持有新冠肺炎病毒陰性測試結果的市民進入食肆、商場或公共地方。你有幾支持或者反對這個建議？」。調查已經開始，結果將於星期五 (8月21日) 下午公布，敬請留意。

Press Invitation (Update)

HKPOP will release tomorrow the Core Social Indicators, People's Most Familiar Political Figures and Details of its Rating Experiment

The Hong Kong Public Opinion Program (HKPOP) under the Hong Kong Public Opinion Research Institute (HKPORI) will hold a press conference **tomorrow (August 18)** afternoon to release the latest findings of core social indicators and people's most familiar political figures. According to the result of our public consultation conducted a while ago, the survey of the 5 core social indicators will be increased to once a month from the second half of this year, while the remaining 20 or so non-core social indicators, freedom and rule of law sub-indicators will remain to be run on a half-yearly cycle. At tomorrow's press conference, HKPOP will also explain its CE Rating Scale Experiment and the total sponsorship received.

HKPOP has re-launched its "We Hongkongers" Initiative in late May. Every week it invites Hong Kong people to suggest current affairs survey questions to it via its Facebook page, then cast their votes online to select the question(s) for its "We Hongkongers Panel Survey", and then release the results. This week's survey is the thirteenth round, and the quota was increased to two questions due to need: "The NPCSC has decided that the current Legislative Council shall continue to discharge duties for no less than one year. How much do you support or oppose all members of the Legislative Council in continuing to serve?" and "Recently some suggested to implement a 'Hong Kong Health Code' system, allowing only people with negative test results for novel coronavirus pneumonia to enter restaurants, shopping malls or public areas. How much do you support or oppose this suggestion?" The survey has already started, results will be announced **this Friday (August 21)** afternoon.
