

限聚指數 – 分析評論 Group Gathering Prohibition Index – Commentary

民生大聯盟發言人章彤輝博士指出,「在經濟和民生角度,何時能夠解禁和實施免隔離通關一直是討論焦點。儘管本地疫情相當穩定,但內地的小爆發令免隔離通關的討論變得遙遠,此時政府應該抓緊機會檢討限聚令,不管是從大眾民意或是各行業的實際營運出發,現階段的限聚尺度不受支持。作為香港社會抗疫的關鍵措施,限聚令應該是我們對抗新冠肺炎的保護網,而現在這個保護網其實更像一道緊箍咒。」

Dr Tung-fai Cheung, Spokesman of Alliance of Revitalizing Economy and Livelihood, observed, "The social gathering ban (SGB) and quarantine free clearance have always been the two key issues of recovering Hong Kong's economy and people's livelihood. Small-scale outbreaks in some mainland areas have ruined the negotiation between the local and mainland governments. It is high time that our government reviewed its social gathering policy. We hardly found any support of the current ban limit from public surveys or various industries based on their actual operations. The SGB should be the most important protective measure of our fight against Covid-19, but it has now become more like a curse than a protection net."




