

- Survey method: Random telephone survey conducted by real interviewers, plus telephone and online interviews with POP Panel samples
- Target population: Cantonese-speaking Hong Kong citizens aged 18+
- Sampling error: Sampling error of percentages not more than +/-3%, that of net values not more than +/-6% at 95% confidence level
- Weighting method: Rim-weighted by day according to figures provided by the Census and Statistics Department. The gender-age distribution of the Hong Kong population came from "Mid-year population for 2018", while the educational attainment (highest level attended) distribution and economic activity status distribution came from "Women and Men in Hong Kong Key Statistics (2018 Edition)".

- Question: There are views in the society saying the 7.21 incident involved collusion of the Police Force and triads. How much do you agree or disagree with this view?




• Question: There are views in the society saying there are Chinese People's Police or People's Armed Police Force in the Police Force. How much do you believe in this view?








- Date of survey: 22-24/10/2019
