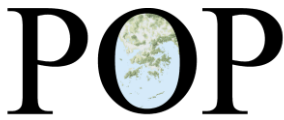

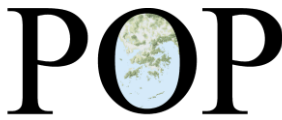

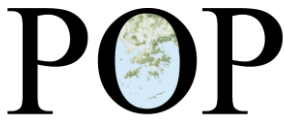

2. Please name or rename your account showing your name and your organisation; people with unclear or sceptical identification may be refused admission.
3. Wait for the host to admit you into the Zoom Meeting Room.
4. During the Q&A session, when you want to raise a question, please submit it in writing to the host at the Zoom Chat Room; this is a backup measure so that in case of technical problem, your question may be read out by the moderator.
5. The host will then give you signal when it is almost your turn to ask your question.
