


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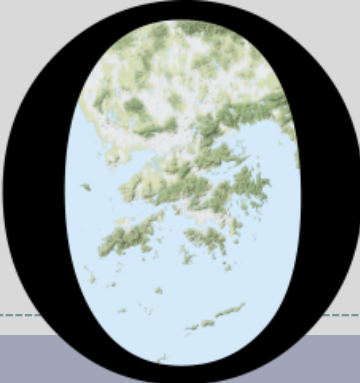

# Contact Information - Survey on Travel Restriction

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- Date of survey: 15-18/11/2021
- Survey method: Random telephone survey conducted by real interviewers
- Target population: Cantonese-speaking Hong Kong residents aged 18 or above
- Sample size: 1,011 (including 507 landline and 504 mobile samples)
- Effective response rate: 55.4%
- Sampling error: At 95% confidence level, the maximum sampling error of all percentages should be no more than 3.1 percentage points
- Weighting method: Rim-weighted according to figures provided by the Census and Statistics Department. The gender-age distribution of the Hong Kong population came from “Mid-year population for 2020”, while the educational attainment (highest level attended) distribution and economic activity status distribution came from “Women and Men in Hong Kong - Key Statistics (2020 Edition)”.



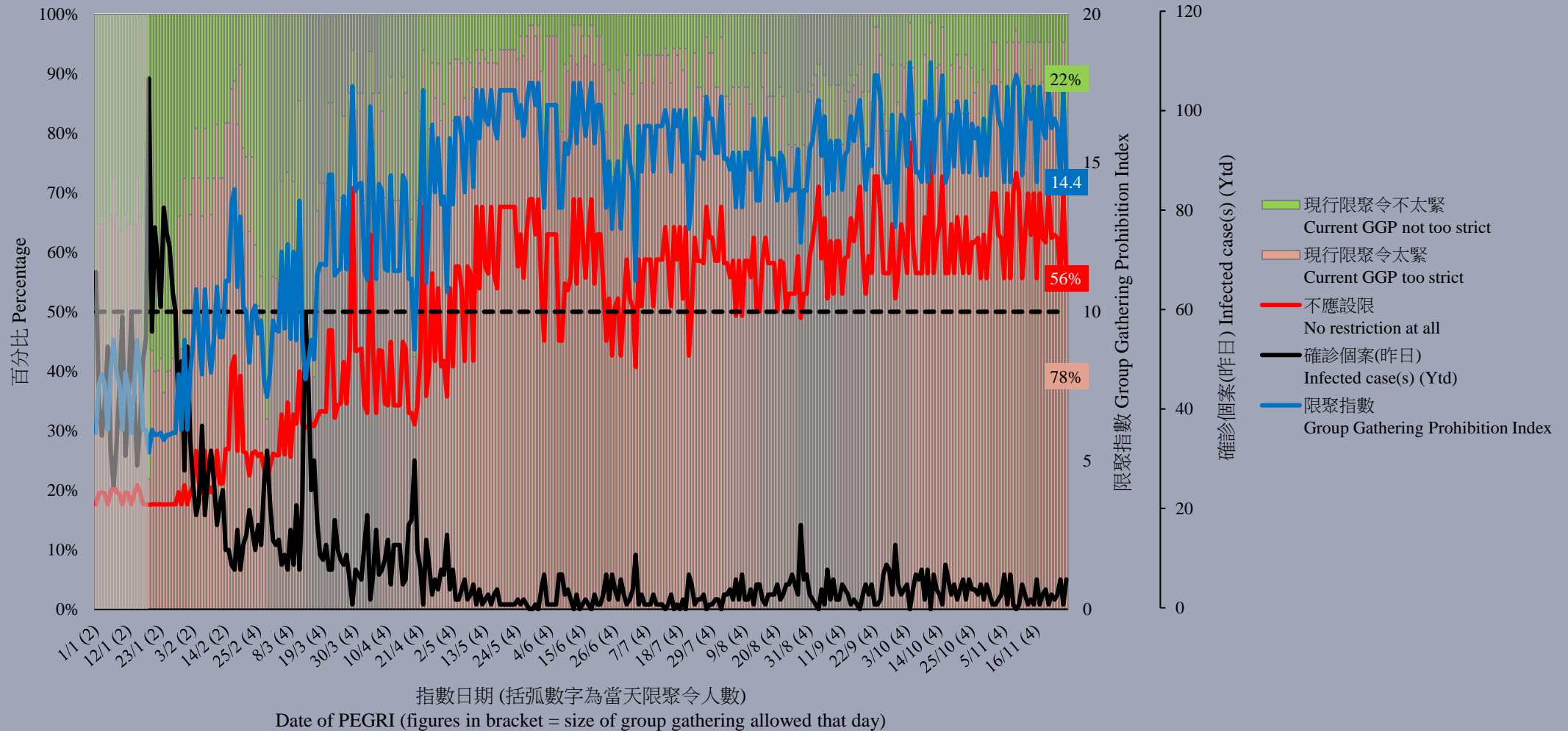


# 限聚指數 - 分析評論

## Group Gathering Prohibition Index – Commentary

獨立評論人潘麒智指出：「為迎接下月十日香港與內地有限度通關，安心出行將於12月9日全面使用。市民無論去到那裡，基本上都要透過安心出行報告行蹤，以便政府監察疫情。然而，市民更期待的是，政府可以順勢放寬，或甚直接取消限聚令，讓市民可以重回昔日生活正軌。本人非常建議政府順應民意，讓市民可安心參與節慶大型活動和一般家庭聚會，免受599G的困擾。」

**Independent commentator KC Poon observed, “In anticipation of the limited border crossing between Hong Kong and the Mainland on December 10, LeaveHomeSafe will be fully operational on December 9. Basically, wherever people go, they have to report their whereabouts through LeaveHomeSafe so that the government can monitor the outbreak. However, what people are looking forward to is that the government can relax or even lift the restriction on gathering, so that people can go back to their normal life. I strongly suggest that the government should respond to the public opinion, so that people can participate in large-scale festive events and general family gatherings without the hassle of 599G.”**

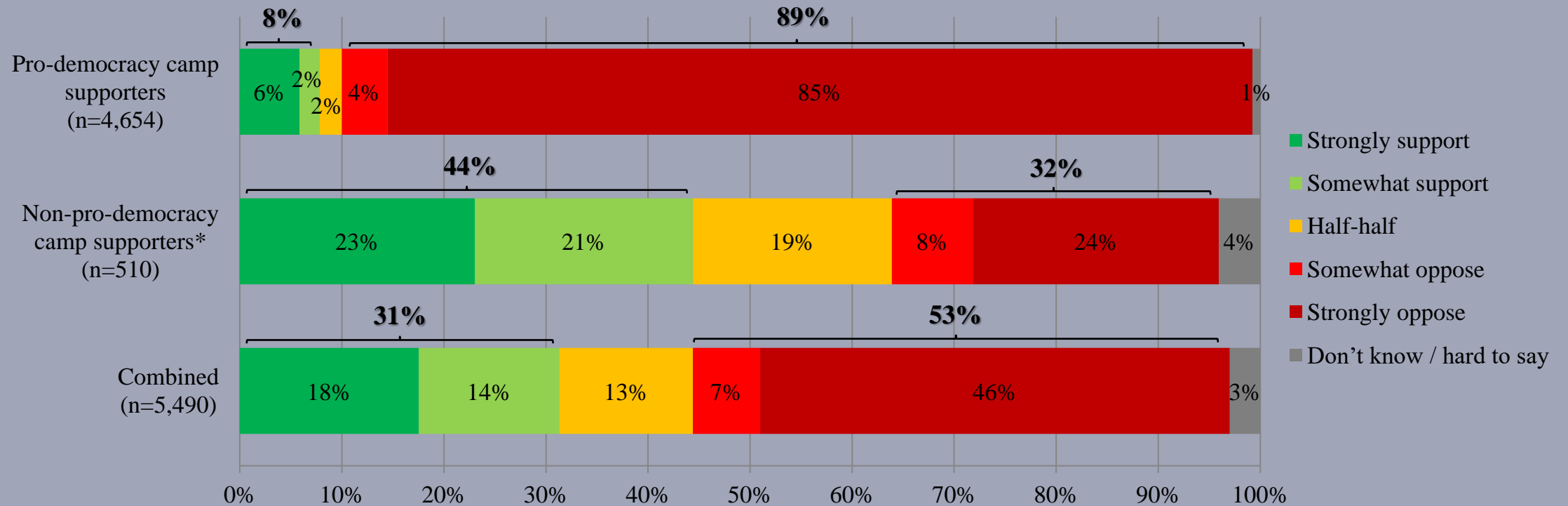

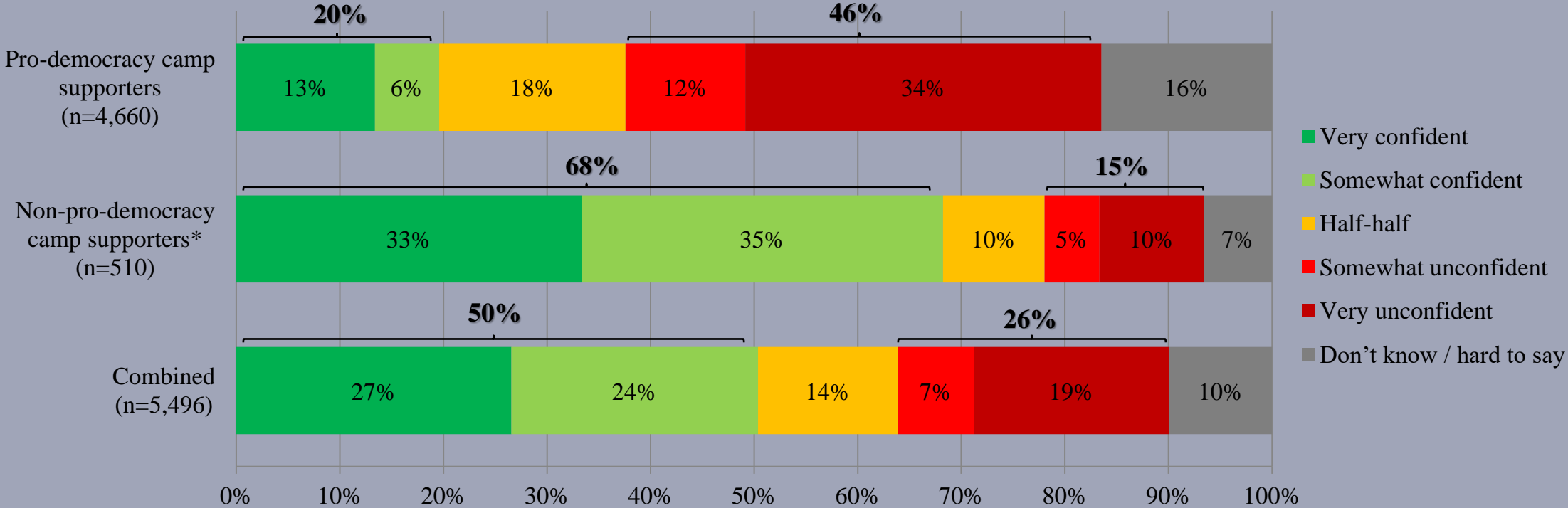

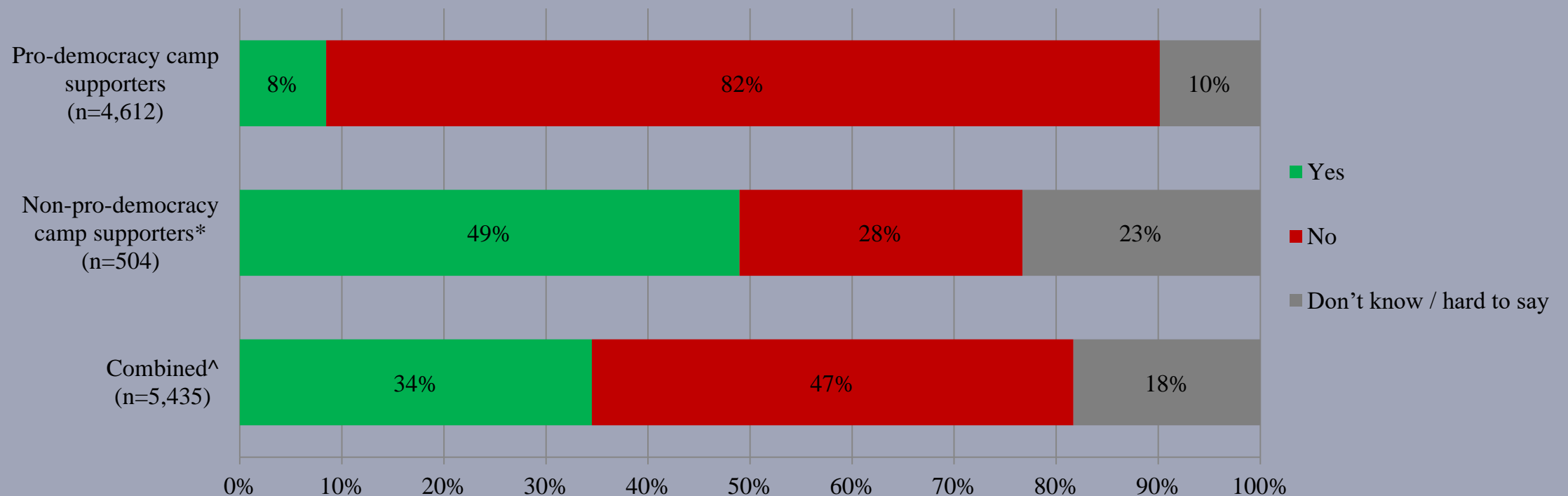
