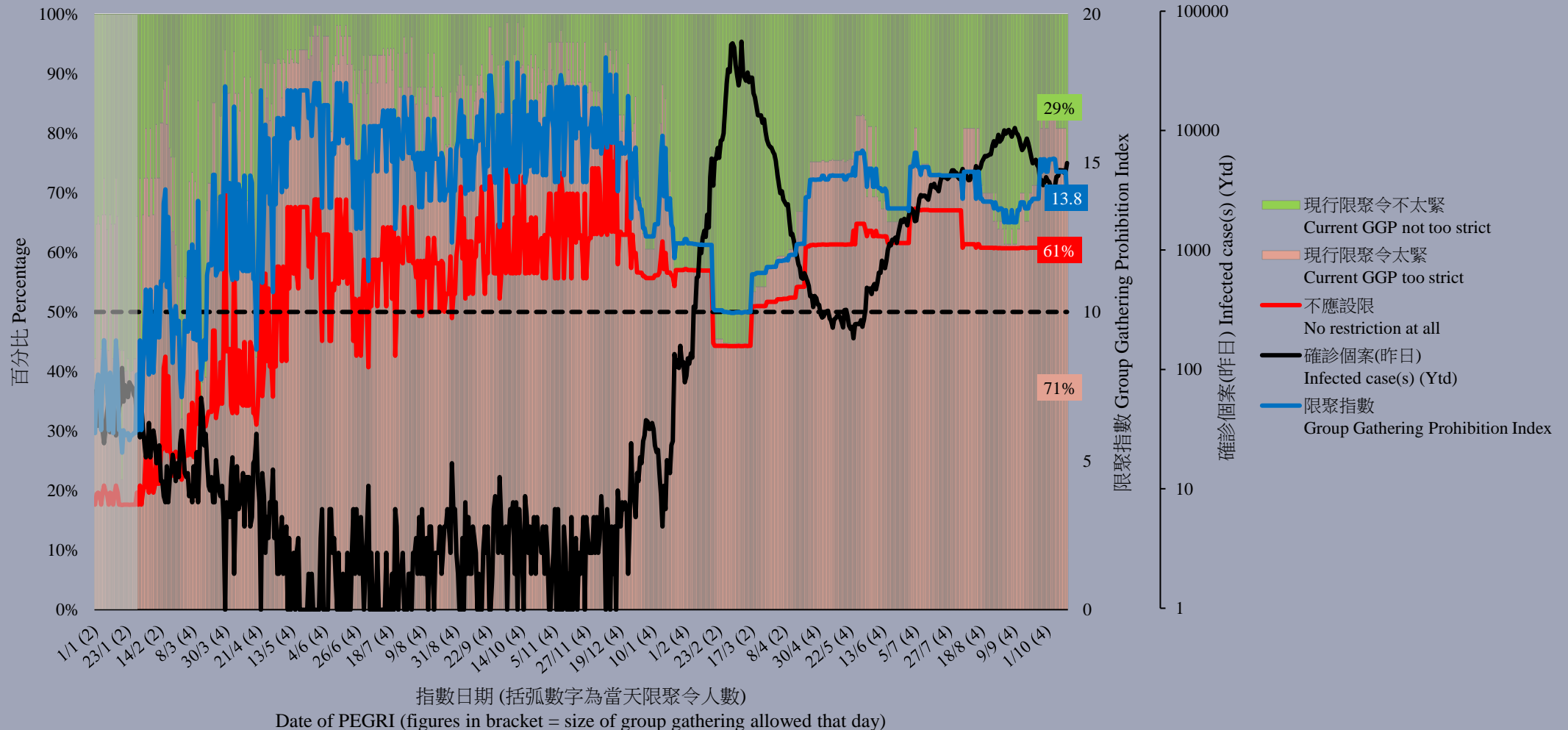

復興經濟民生大聯盟成員任偉豪指出：「現在全港商界都嚷著要求放寬到0+0,但我認為放不放寬已經無所謂了，因為現在已完全錯過了0+0開放的時機。大部份人都幻想放寬到0+0後經濟就會復甦。最絕望的真相是，在放寬後發覺經濟毫無起色，原本很多在硬撐的公司，包括飲食業和旅遊相關的行業就會一下子全面崩潰。全面衰退的禍根早已被種下，不能回頭。另外我要勉勵一下因免針紙作廢被辭退的朋友，千萬不用擔心找不到工作，因為現在各行各業因移民潮都很缺人，而你不是因工作能力原因被辭退的，絕對會是被極多公司搶奪的員工。」

Yam Wai Ho, member of Alliance of Revitalizing Economy and Livelihood observed, "Now the whole Hong Kong business community is clamoring for the relaxation to 0+0, but I think it does not matter whether it is relaxed or not, because the opportunity of 0+0 opening has been completely missed now. Most people imagine that the economy will recover after relaxing to 0+0. The most desperate truth is that after the relaxation, it is found that there is no improvement in the economy, and many companies that were originally struggling, including the catering industry and tourism-related industries, will collapse all at once. The bane of a full-blown recession has long been sown and cannot be turned back. In addition, I would like to encourage friends who were dismissed due to the cancellation of medical exemption certificate. Don't worry about finding a job, because now all industries are short of people due to immigration, and you are not dismissed because of your working ability. You absolutely are welcomed by lots of employers."

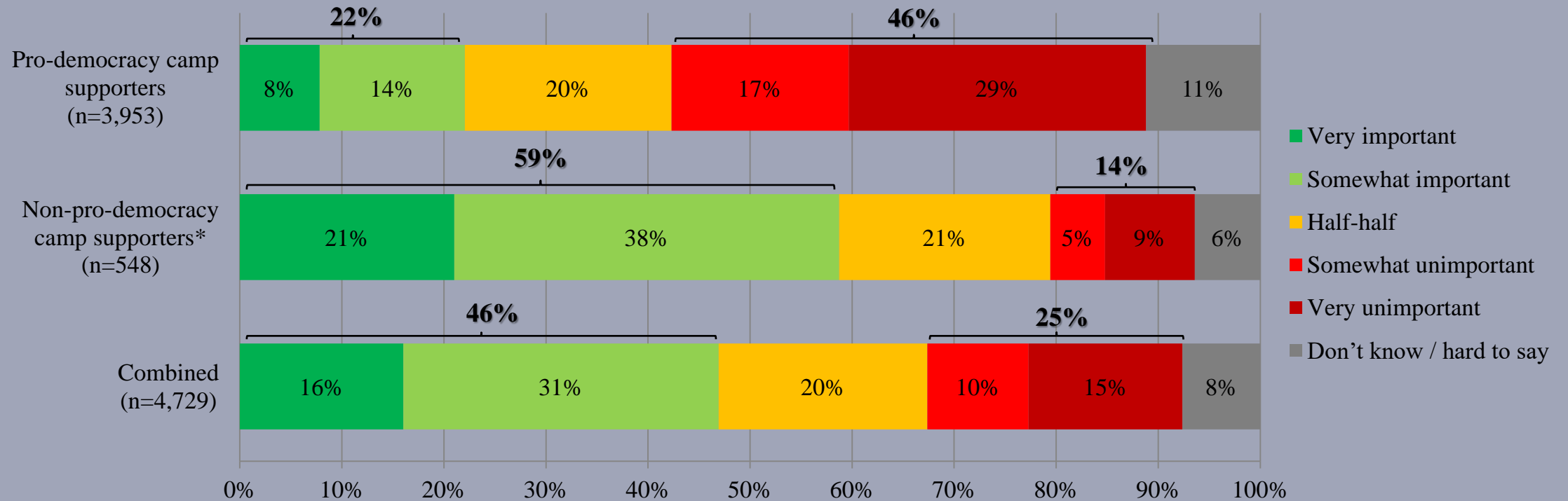

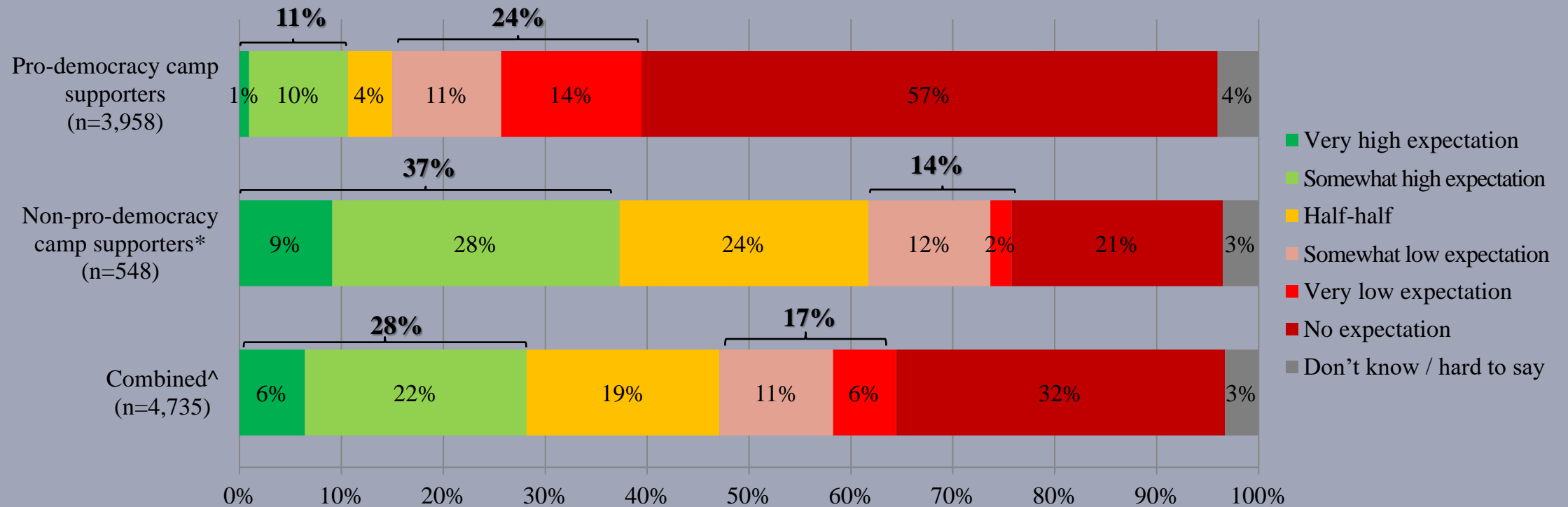

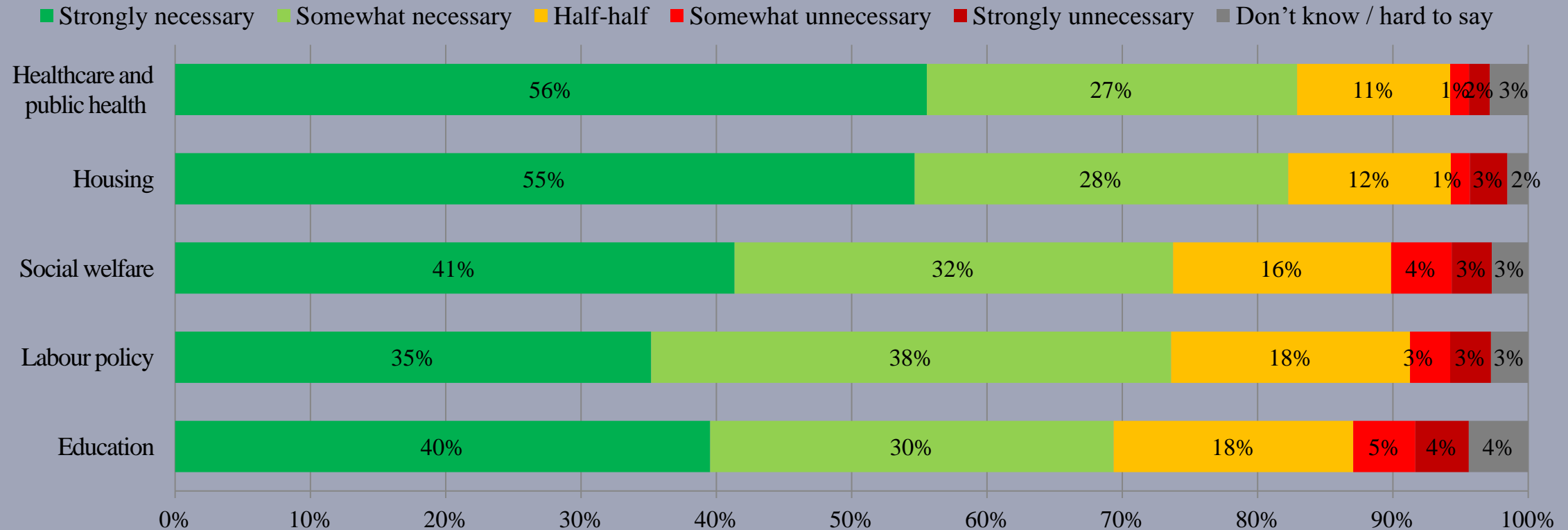

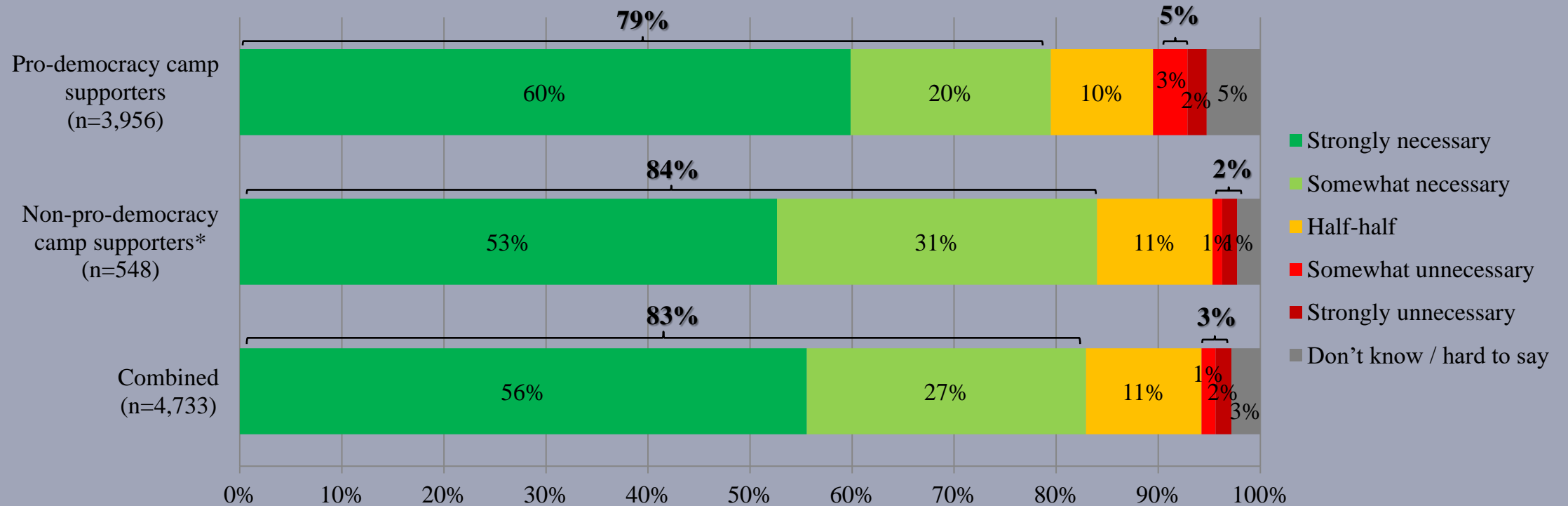

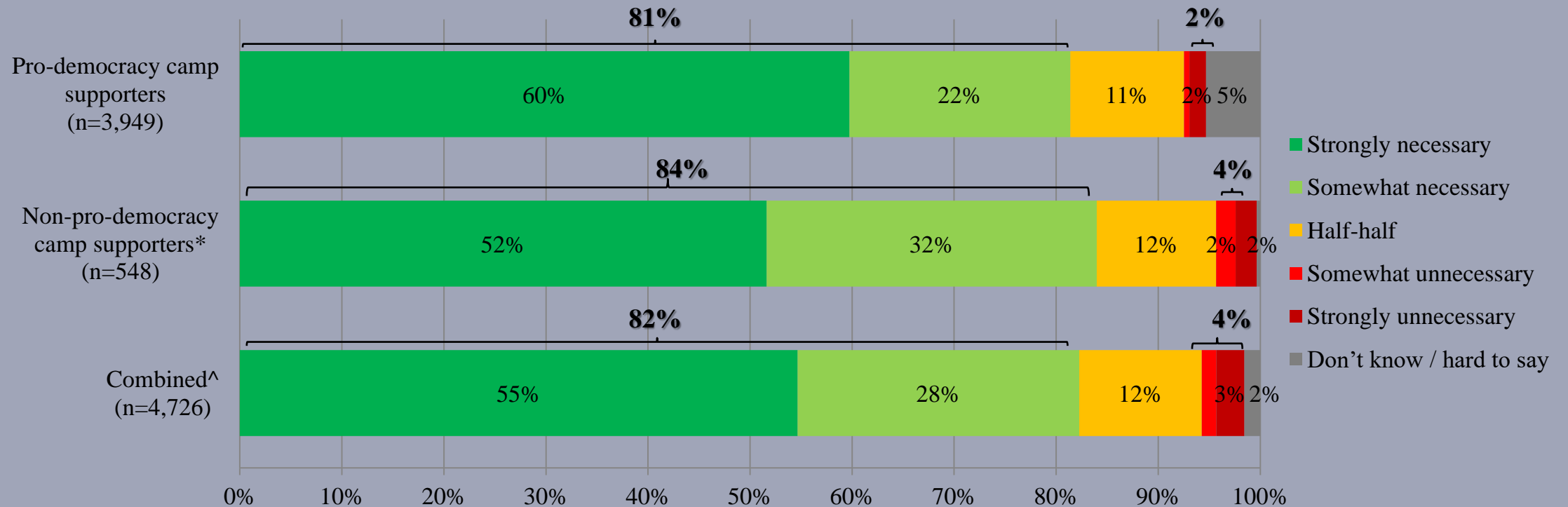

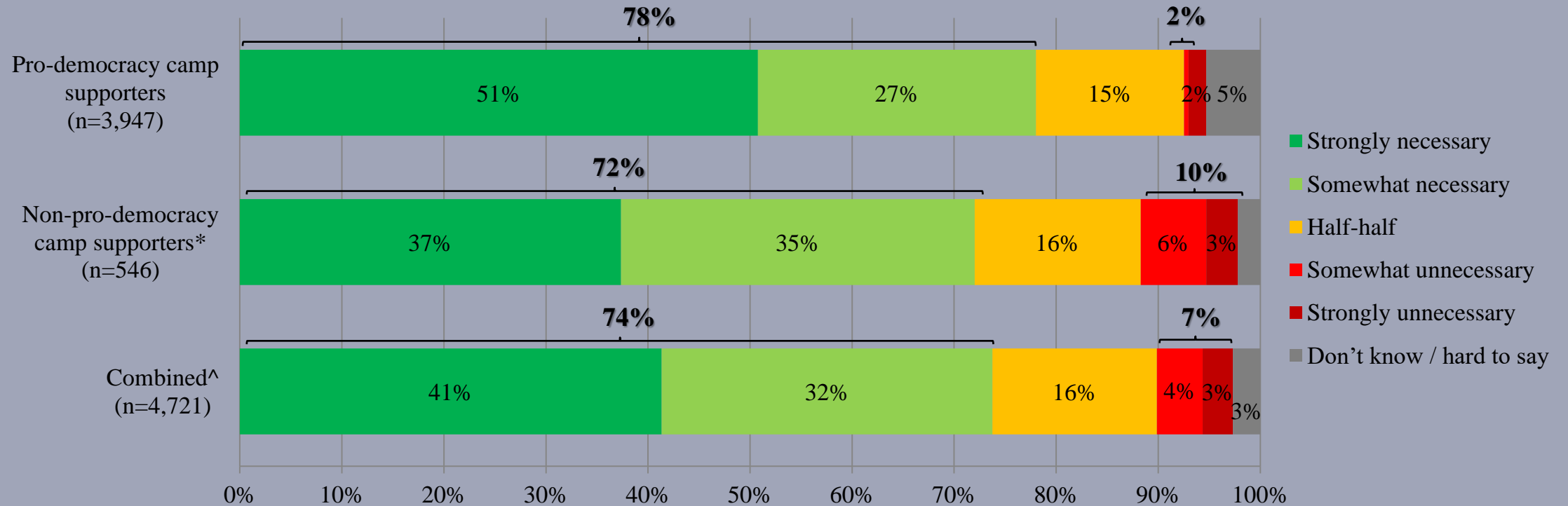

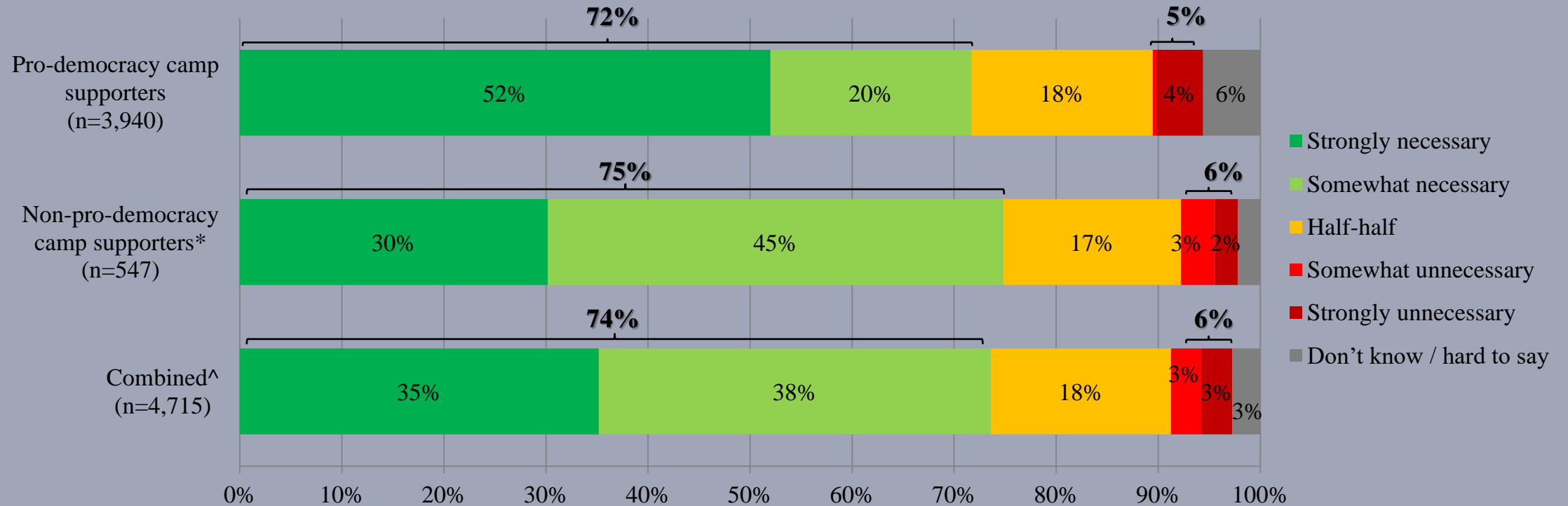

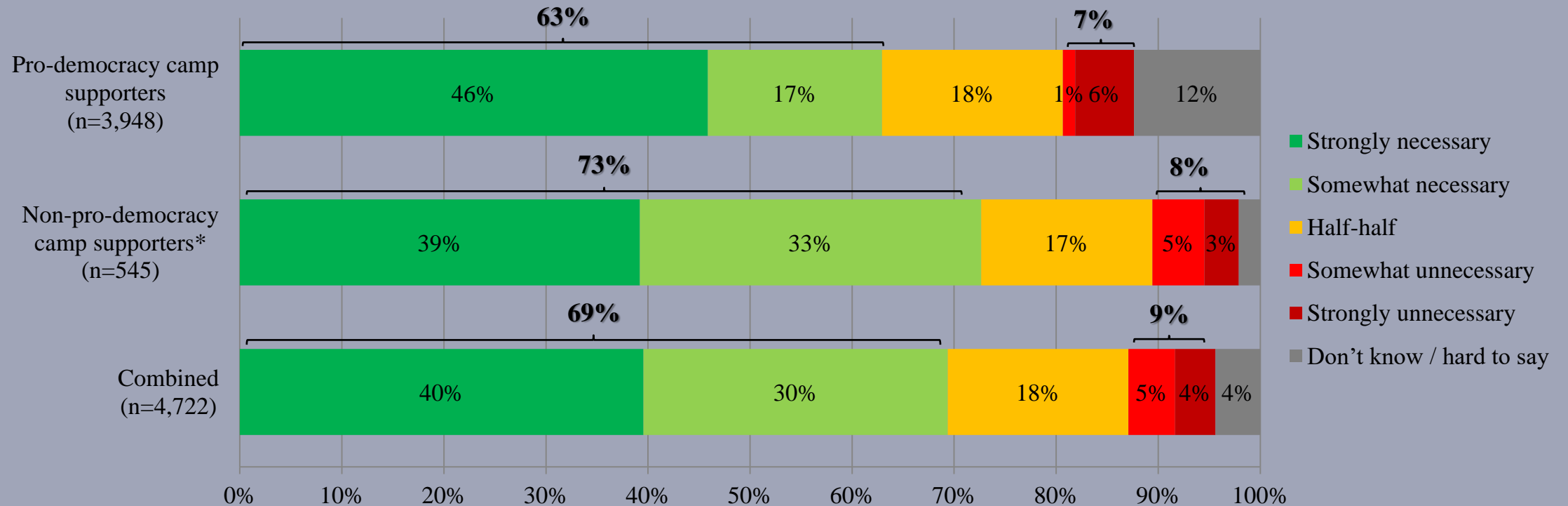

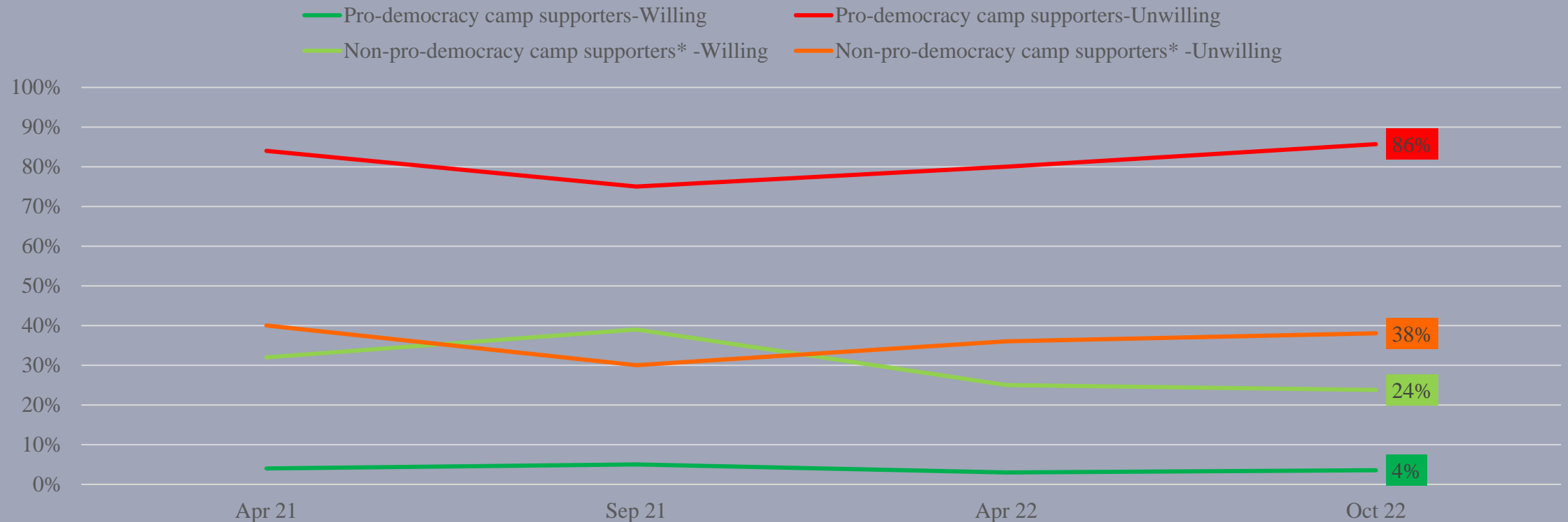

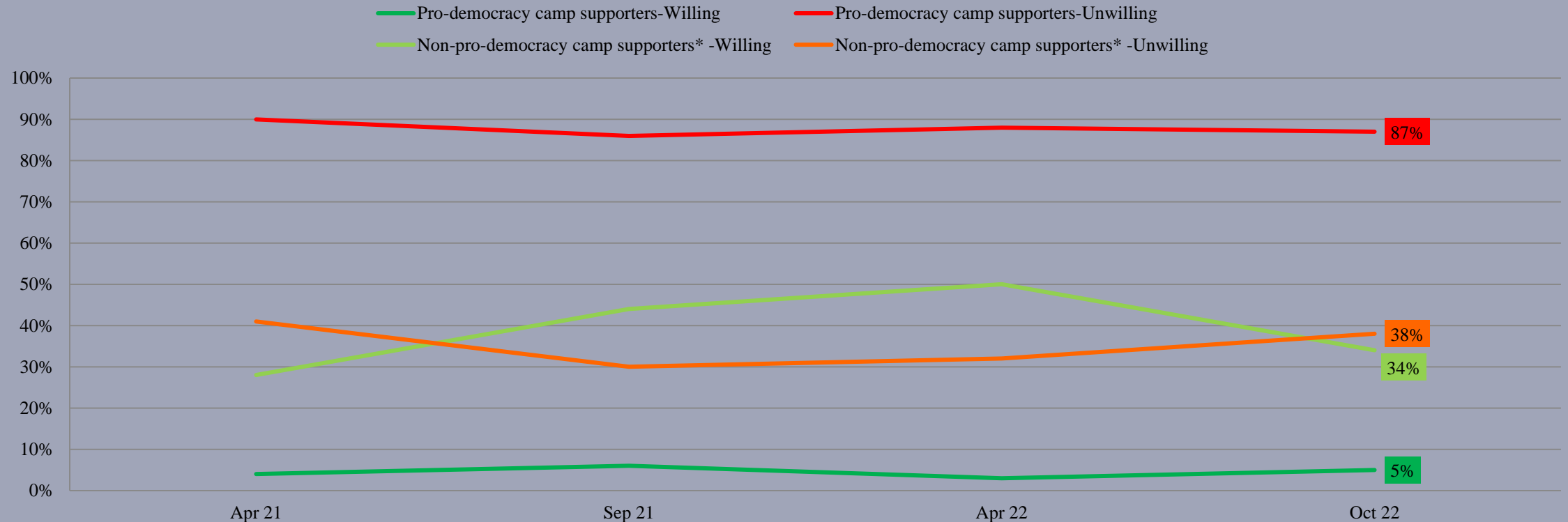
