

Group Gathering Prohibition Index – Commentary

復興經濟民生大聯盟成員任偉豪指出:「確診數字天天上升,疫情現在是否嚴峻? 如果我們現在是嚴峻的話,為何昨天又放寬防疫措施?如果是不嚴峻的話,維持0+3、 口罩令、限聚令、安心出行、疫苗通行證又有什麼意義呢?但無論嚴不嚴峻,這些 措施現在對控制疫情根本沒有用,但對打擊經濟很有作用。」

Yam Wai Ho, member of Alliance of Revitalizing Economy and Livelihood observed, "The number of confirmed cases is rising every day. Is the epidemic serious now? If yes, why the epidemic prevention measures were relaxed yesterday? If not, what is the point of maintaining 0+3, mask order, gathering restriction, leave home safe, and vaccine pass? But whether severe or not, these measures are now of no use in controlling the epidemic, but useful for destructing the economy."






